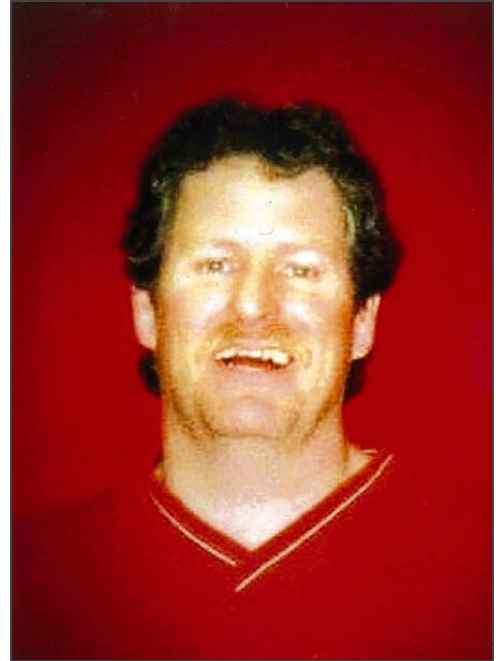


Michael Tait
