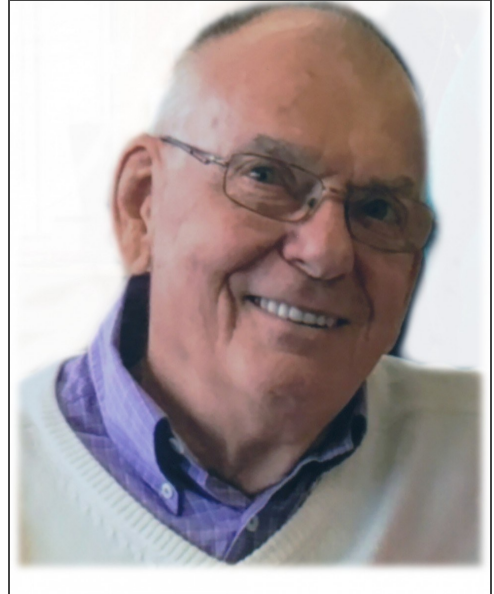


Joseph Tarnoczi
