

# Irene Thomas

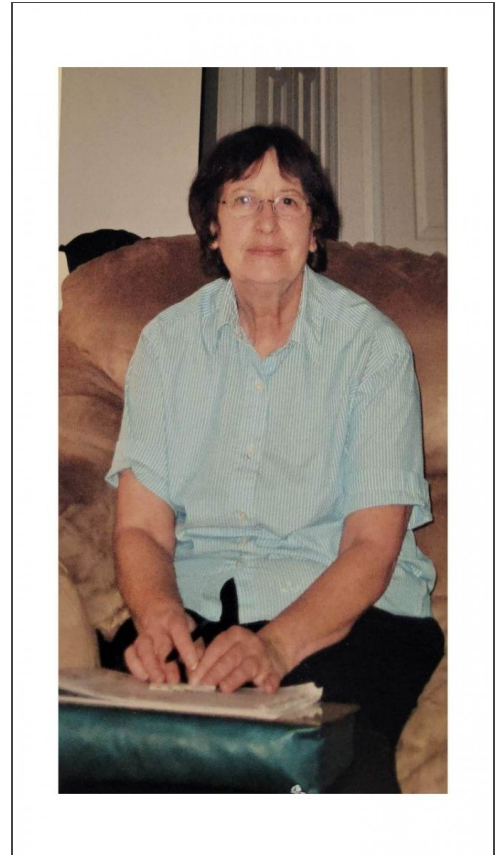
