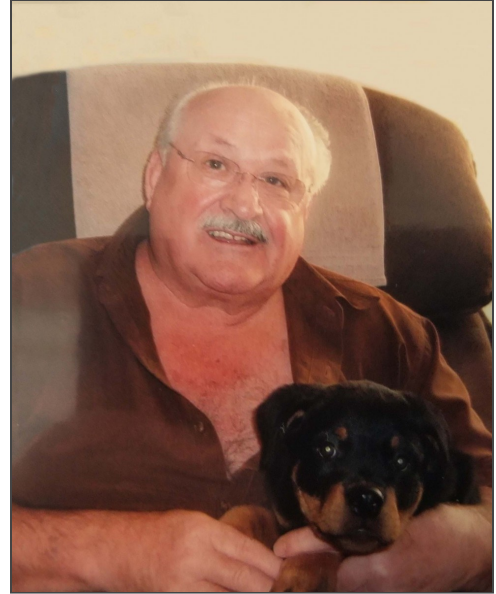


Gordon Clarence Toderan
