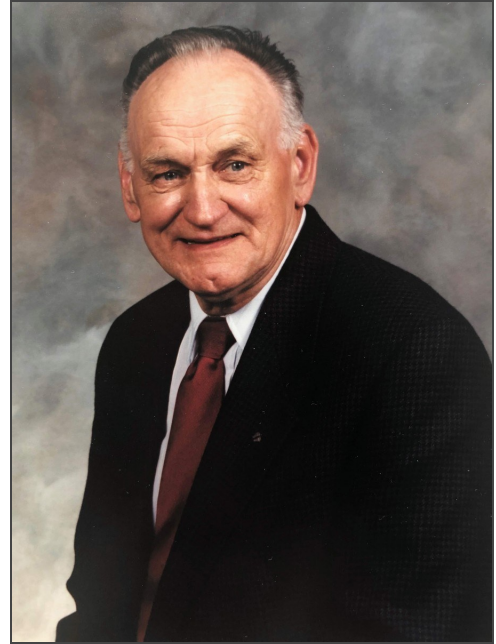


Mark Ballantyne Leonard Toth
