It is with broken hearts and great disbelief that we announce the sudden passing of Noah James Toth on October 30, 2024.

Noah is the beloved son of Amanda Toth, and adored older brother to Peyton. He was born in Regina, SK a week later than expected, on July 3, 2007 because he was too stubborn to arrive on his due date. A trait he maintained throughout his entire life.

In Noah's 17 short years on earth he touched the lives of more people than most do in a hundred years. He was the kindest, sweetest, most caring boy anyone has ever been privileged enough to meet. He knew how to fix a vehicle before he could even spell the names of the parts he needed. He could sweet talk you into thinking something was your idea, even though you were dead set against the idea, when the conversation started.

Noah's natural athletic ability led him throughout his entire life. He spent many days, when he should have been doing homework, out at the ski hill teaching dozens of kiddos to ski. His patience with children was endless and there isn't a face at the hill that didn't know his name. He was equally as skilled on his snow board, and spent all his time in the sunshine. It was absolutely impossible to go anywhere with Noah without taking in account time for all his chats. Noah knew everyone and everyone loved Noah.

There never was a boy with more spirit or tenacity than Noah James. These gifts are the reason he was good at everything he tried and why he accomplished as much as he did in such a short time. These gifts are also the reason his mom has grey hair.

Noah was predeceased by his great grandparents Julius and Irma Toth and Cecil and Verna Emmerson.
