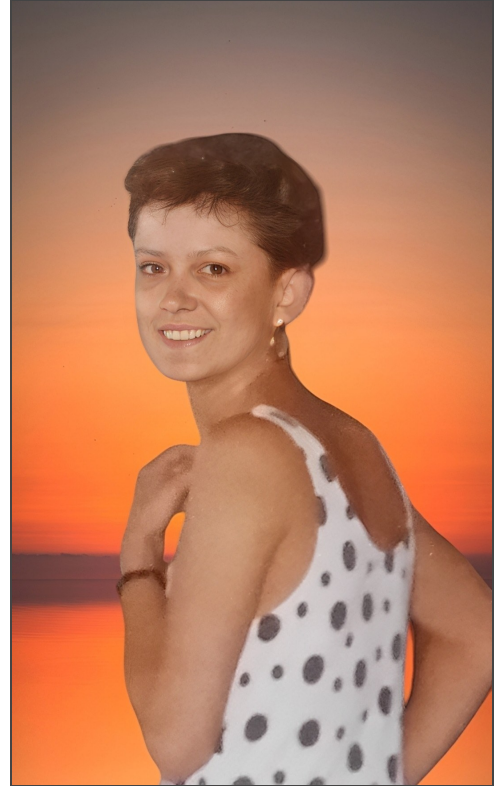


Tracy Anne Moore
