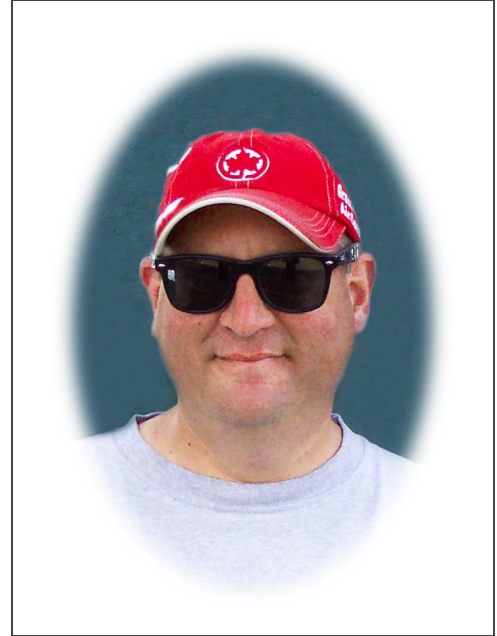


Roger John Treau
