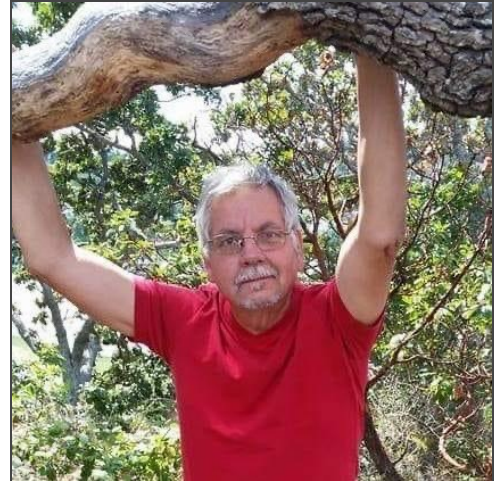


Daniel Tremblay
