It is with great sadness we announce the passing of George Trithart 2 days short of his 99th birthday with his family by his side.

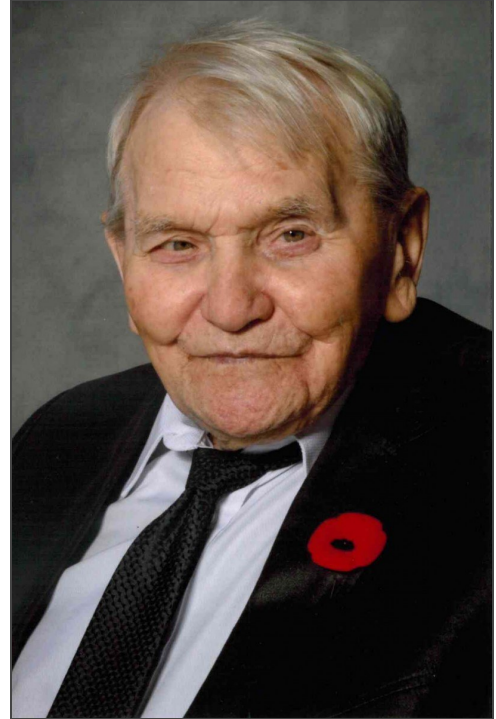
George passed peacefully from this world on February 13, 2022.
