Lorne was born in Wetaskiwan, Alberta on November 7, 1948 and left this world to be with his Lord and Saviour on Monday, July 12, 2021.

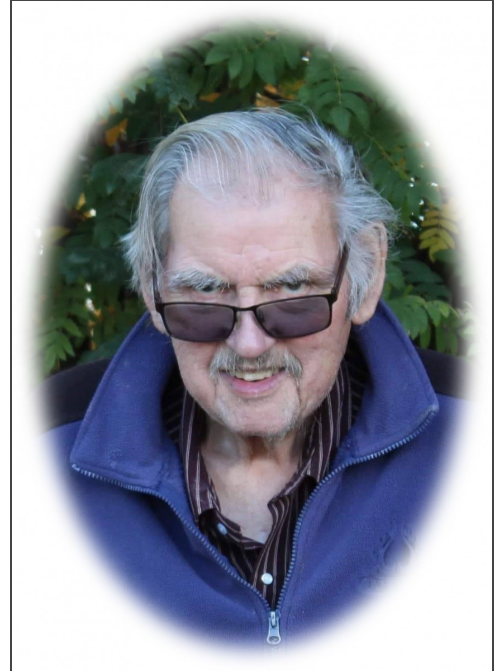
