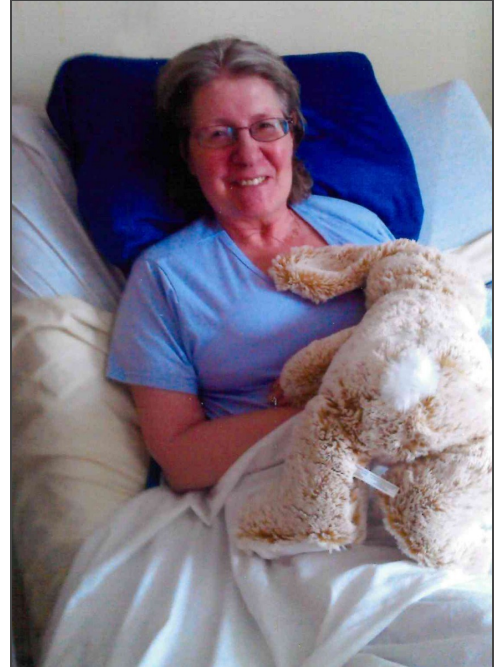


# Debra Louise Tuchscherer
