with Bill Twemlow. They were married November 3, 1951.

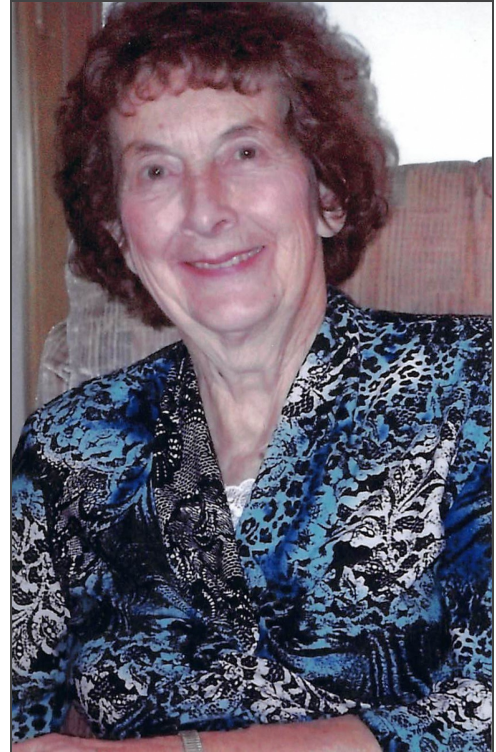
Moving to the Twemlow farm, they farmed dairy and beef cattle, along with large
