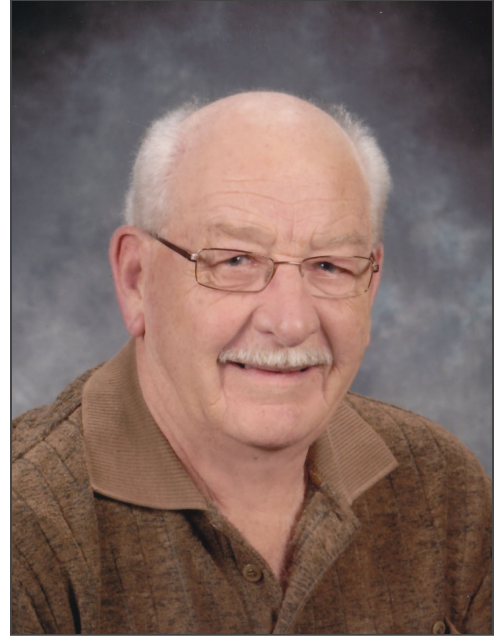


Clifford Norman Ulmer
