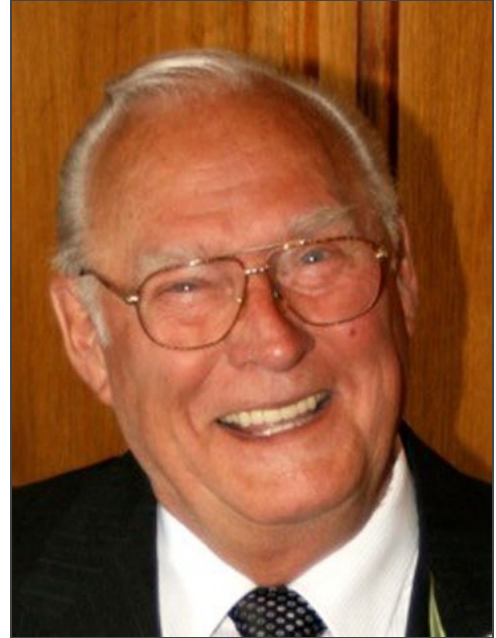


George Robert Urquhart
