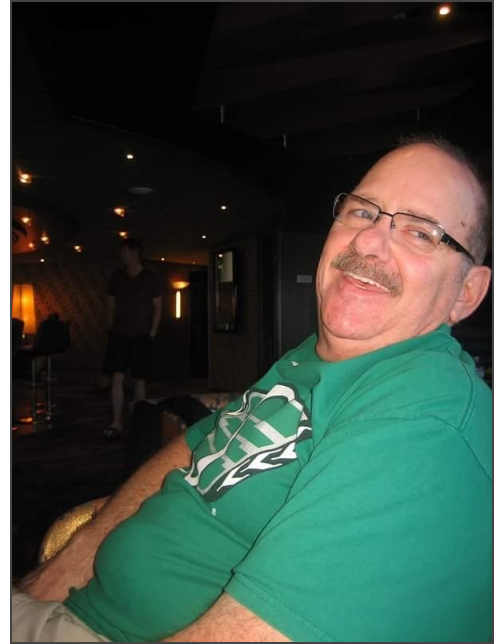


Bill Urschel
