

John Steve Varsegi

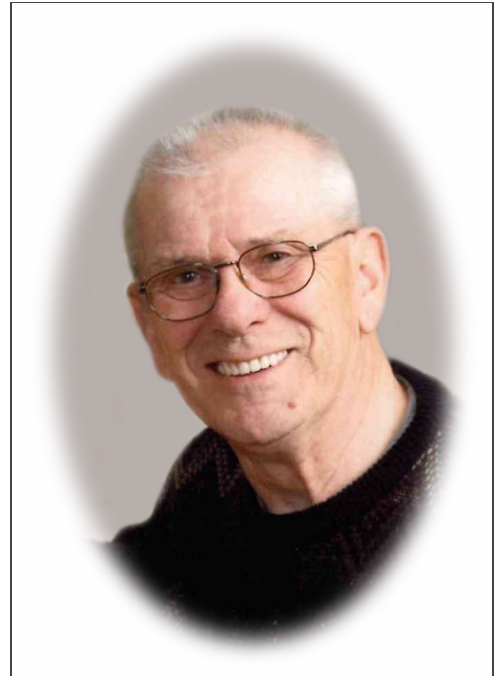
