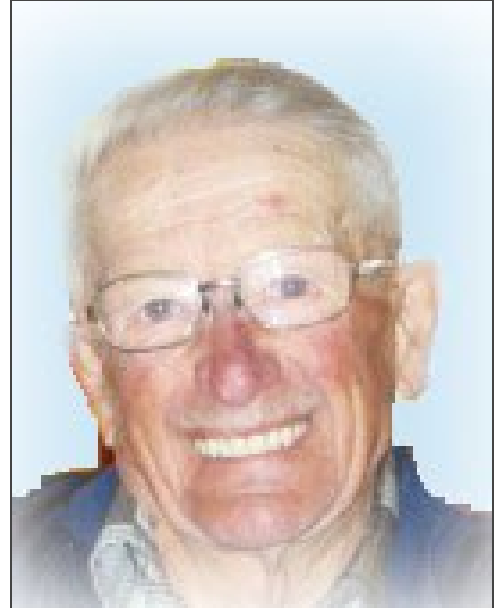


# Cornelius "Cory" Veldhoen
