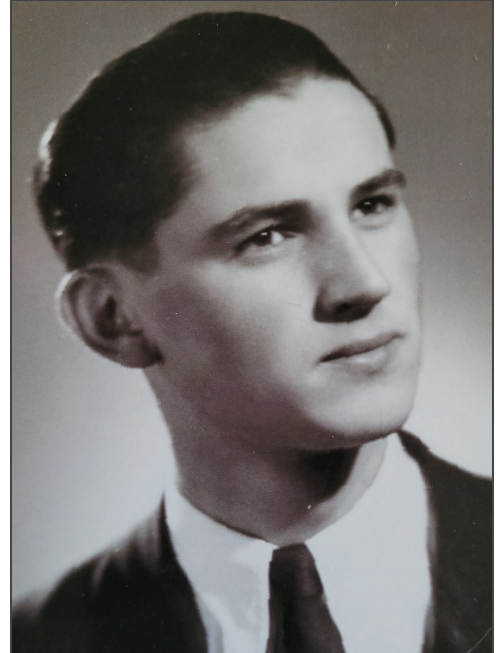


Stephen Vouszka
