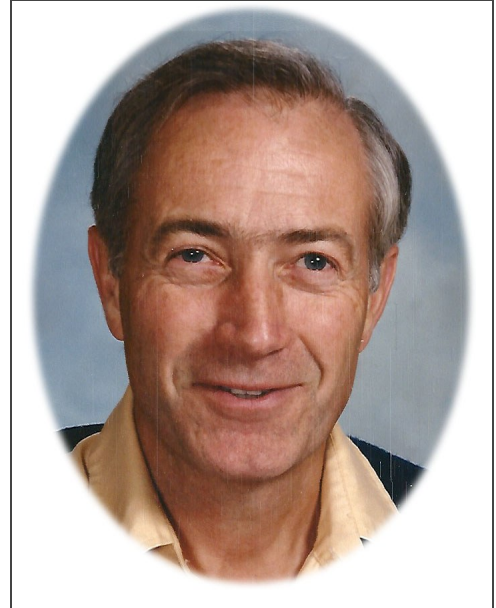


Raymond Wesley Walker
