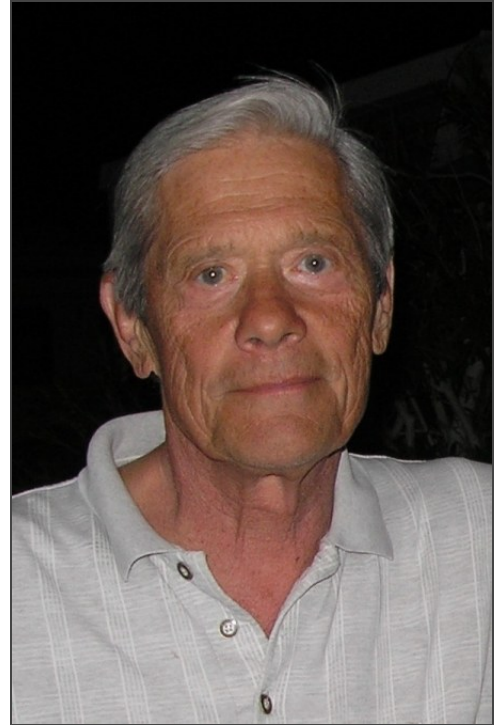


# Richard William Waller
