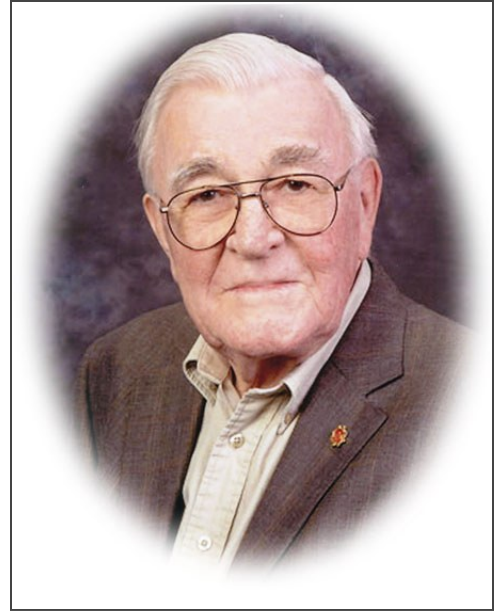


Bertram "Bert" Lewis Walsh
