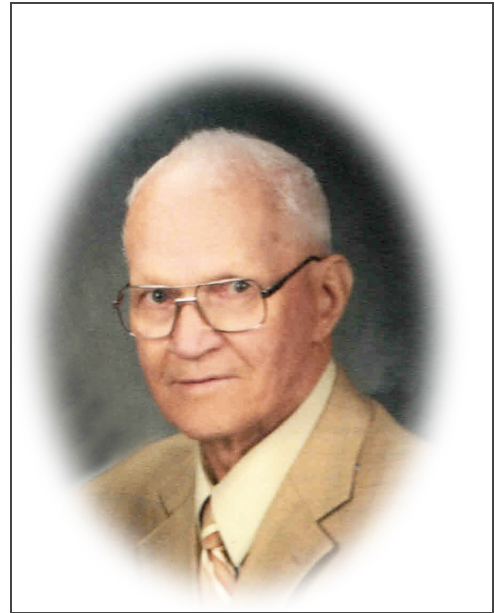
Darwin (Diane), Greg (Myrna), his
