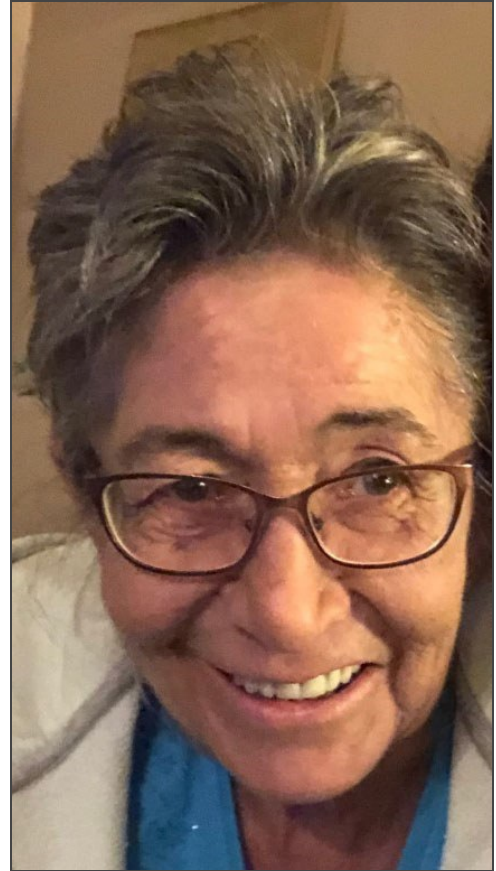


# Marlene Fay Ward
