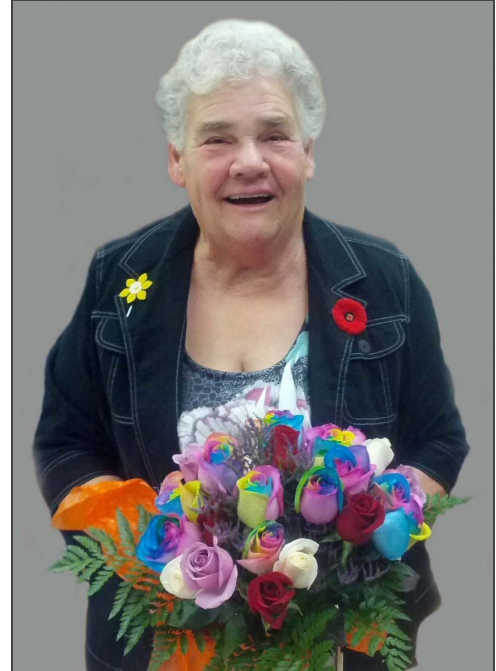


Sharon Elizabeth Ward
