Gordon (Gord) Lenard Waterhouse

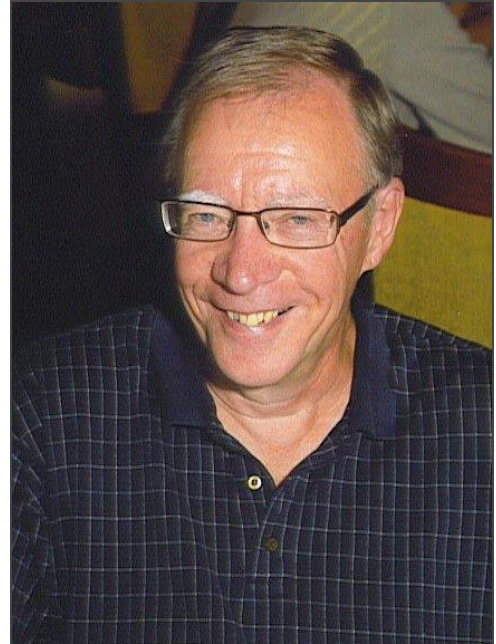
March 12th, 1943, to October 24th, 2022
