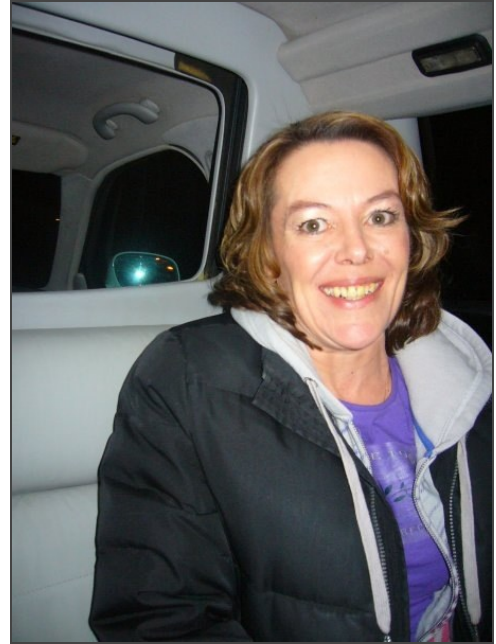


Penny Doreen Weibel
