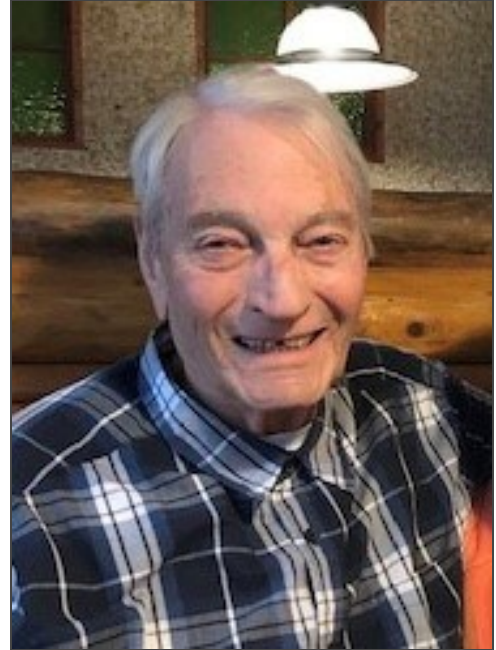


Bill (Wilhelm) Weinbender
