

# David Dennis Welter

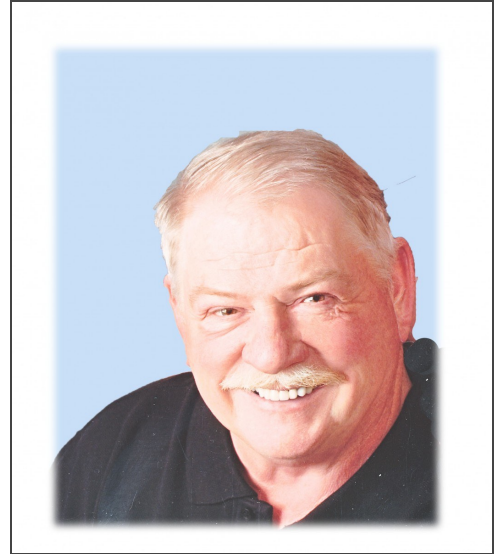
