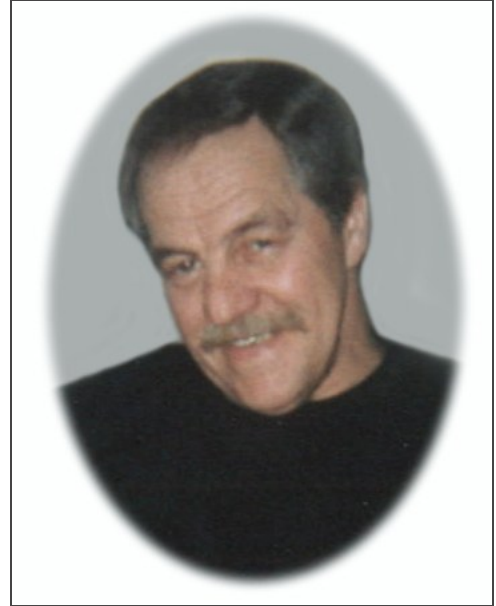


Otto Donald Welz
