Roy was born on January 18, 1960 in Edmonton, Alberta to Russell and Ella Whetter. He grew up and spent his childhood with his six siblings Sandy, Marty, Al, Daryl, Ron and Nancy in Canmore, Alberta until age 9, and then in Crossfield, Alberta.
