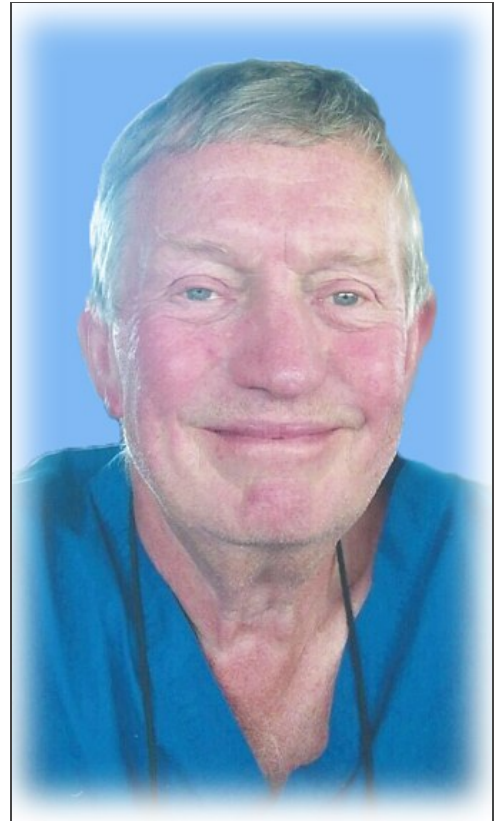
Murray Gordon Wilcox
