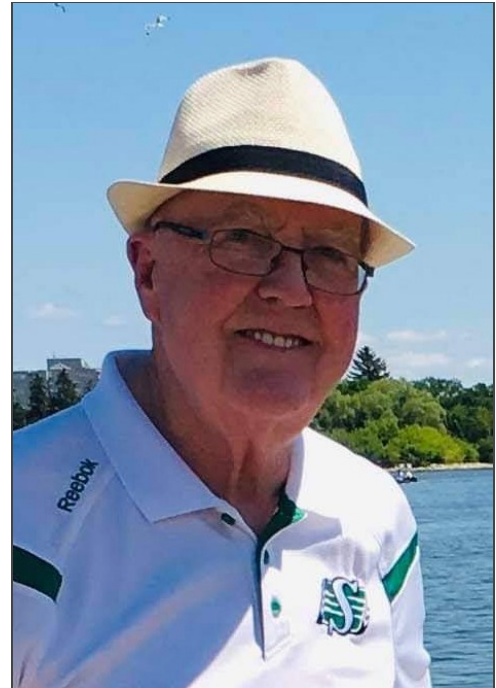


Orville Roy Wiley
