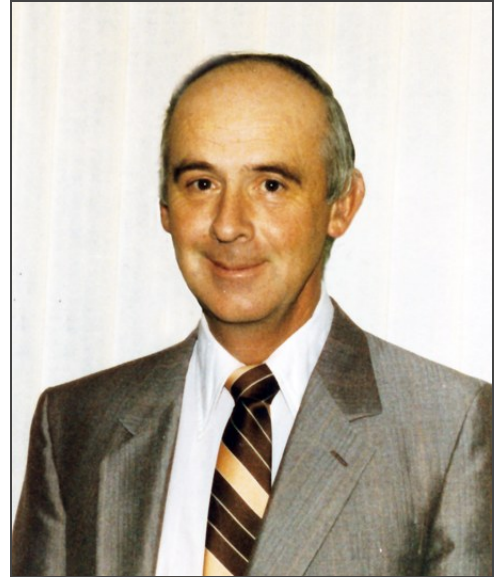


# Gerald (Gerry) Albert Wilkinson
