Her other schooling was at Elsie Mironuk, WH Ford, then onto Winston Knoll Collegiate. After graduating Winston Knoll she was accepted at the Cosmopolitan Learning Centre where she spent almost 17 years, under their care and guidance. Jaymie developed into the centres “social butterfly” and “super helper”. She spent her days socializing and helping out whenever and where ever she could, and having fun with the workers and clients alike. She especially enjoyed the outings with her besties, Amanda and Judy.

During Jaymie's 7 week stay in Palliative Care, Jaymie developed a special relationship with the nursing staff, where they had mutual love and affection for

each other.
