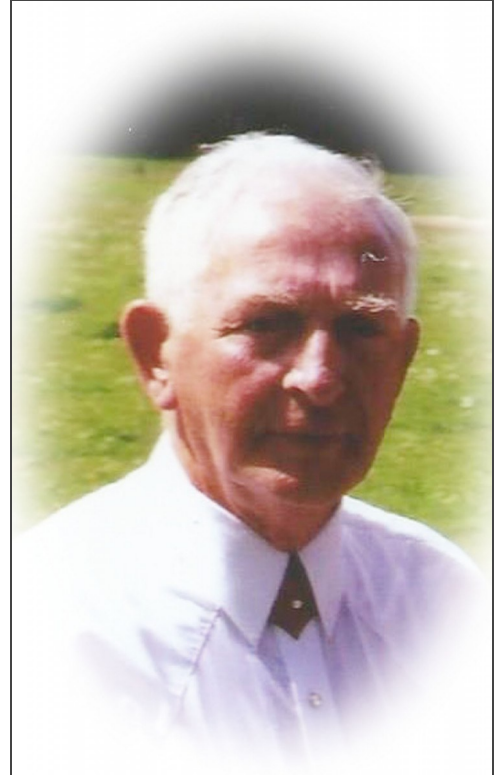


Hendrik "Hank" Winters
