It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Poon - Johnny Wong on the morning of March 1st, 2022 after a brave 4 month battle with bladder cancer at the age of 78 years old. Johnny passed away peacefully with family members by his side. A lot of time, he would do this through his cooking and was well known for his Johnny Burger and Veal Cutlets. One of his favourite and many people's sought-after events in Lafleche was his Chinese New Year's feast. His time in Lafleche was well spent and he made many lifelong friends. He was extremely sharp and enjoyed playing cribbage and Chinese chess with his friends and family. Johnny had a

strong sense of family responsibility and worked hard all his life to provide for his family, but always managed to find time to enjoy life. These traits and many more will continue to live through his grateful children.
