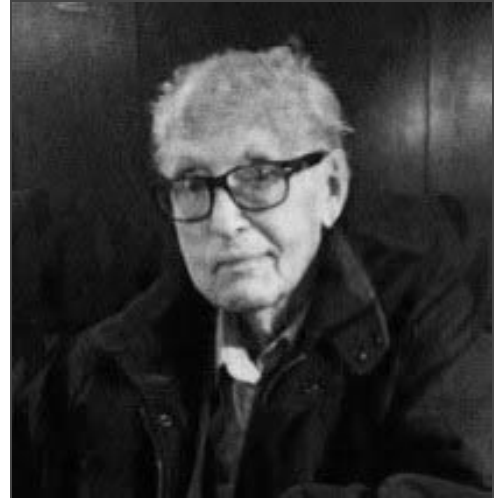


# Gerald Stuart Wren
