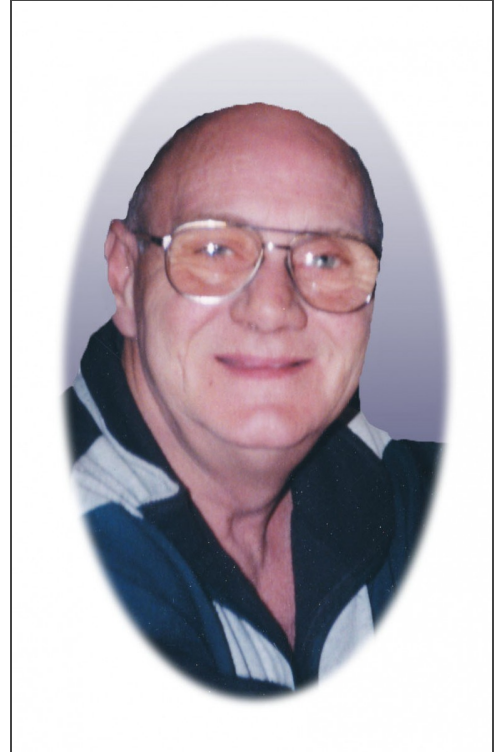


Peter Wright
