

Ernst Gunther Wunnemann

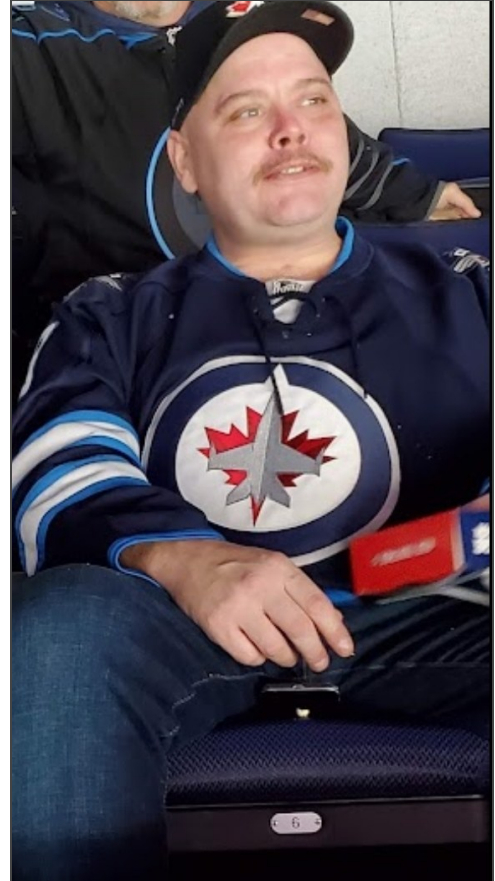
