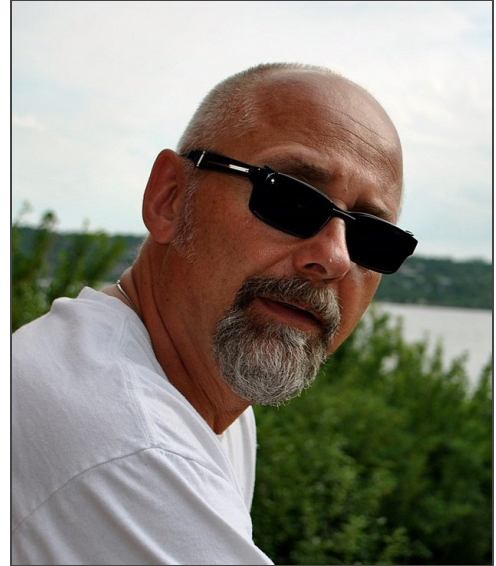


Adonis Yaworski
