

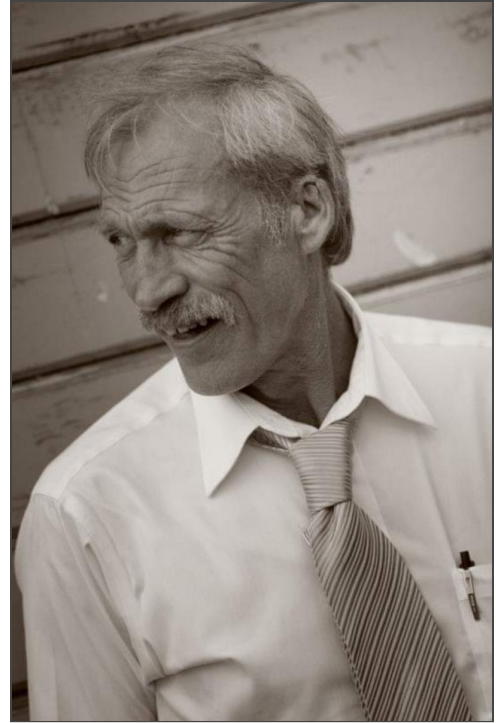
# Raymond Yeoman
