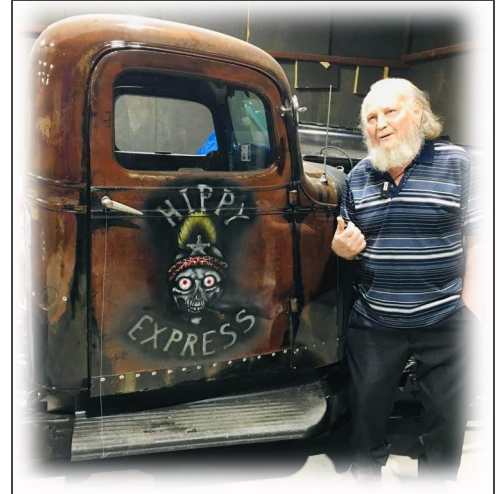


# Melvin Leroy Yorgason
