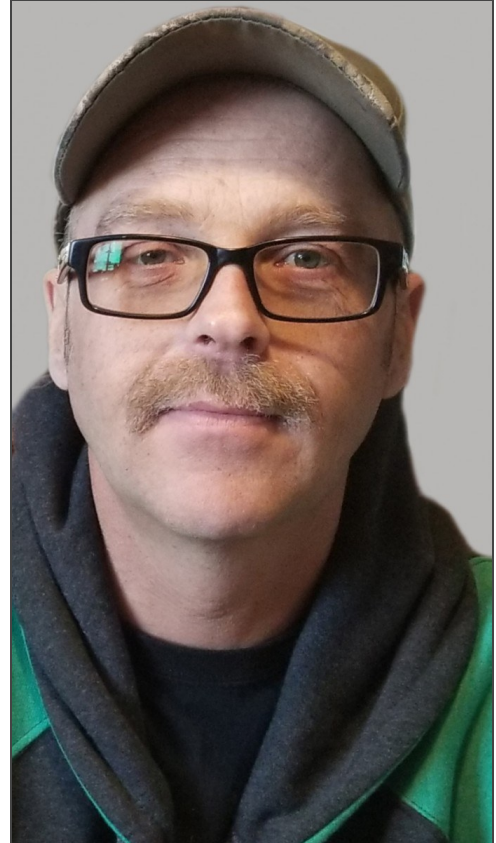


David Mark Zatylny
